He is Risen! He Is Risen, Indeed!

Nothing is as it seems. The essence of Christian faith and life, the heart of our hope, is the resurrection of Jesus of Nazareth from the dead. Jesus' resurrection, to put it mildly, is the cornerstone of our faith. The same Jesus who was crucified, who died on the Tree, who was buried in a borrowed tomb, and descended into the grave – this same Lord was raised from the dead on the third day, triumphant over death and able to save all who call on him in faith.

Every single Gospel account of our Lord's resurrection demonstrates its power and mystery. With the women coming to the Tomb toward the dawn of the first day of the week, the entire episode unfolded – the angel of the Lord's descent from heaven and the rolling away of the stone. We see the battle-worn guards fall like dead men at the shaking of the earthquake and the presence of the angel's splendor. The angel tells the women a message totally unexpected: the crucified Jesus is no longer in the tomb, but has risen from the dead, just as he said. He tells them to go and tell his disciples to meet the Lord in Galilee as he promised, and as they leave with fear and great joy, they encounter the risen Lord himself, and worship him. He comforts them, and tells them to go and tell his "brothers" that he will meet them in Galilee, as he told them beforehand.

This amazing tale is the reason we can have hope in a world so dark and feeble, so confused as to what really matters, and so discouraged over what is really possible. All the prophets and apostles agree: the Messiah of God had to suffer, but God declared that he would rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance and forgiveness of sins would be preached in his name to the entire world, beginning from Jerusalem. Now death is dead; now life and hope spring forth! God can raise the dead, the curse is broken, the devil and his minions are defeated, and hope of eternal life is offered in Jesus' name. We need neither fear nor shrink back. Our Lord, who is the

Firstborn, our Elder Brother, is alive forevermore, granting life and grace who all who call upon him, and guaranteeing that all who believe will never die.



We can expect genuine revival in the midst of the dark city, for the risen Christ is neither intimidated nor overwhelmed by the dark. He is alive, able to penetrate every home, street corner, neighborhood, or community where Satan now rules. He can break the power of sin, overcome the tyranny of fear, and raise to life even those hopes which seem smashed and dead. Because he lives everything can be renewed, and his name speaks life to all who believe.

Let us cling by faith to the reality of the risen Lord, and affirm with joy and hope that the One we represent in the city has now been given a name above every name, that he is risen from the dead, and well able to save all those who come to God through him. This is the hope of our lives, the strength of our hope, the confidence of our ministry, and the surety of our faith.

Global Strategic Vision

Pray fervently and in faith for the following *Gateway Cities in the* 10/40 *Window*. Ask the Lord of the harvest for more spiritual laborers, greater opportunities and open doors, for the manifestation of the Holy Spirit, and seeds planted for church planting movements in each city.

Northern Africa: Conakry and Tunis

• Middle East: Amman and Kuwait City

Central Asia: Bishkek and Male
Eastern Asia: Taiyuan and Jinan

Pray fervently for these great cities, supplicating on their behalf before the Lord, asking him to pour out his own dear Holy Spirit upon them, that the Gospel of Christ might penetrate every dimension of these societies, and that the Church could be planted within each of these influential Gateway cities. Let us entreat the Lord on behalf of these key cities, believing God for his intervention:

• Pray for an outpouring of God's Holy Spirit within *Conakry* and *Tunis*. In *Conakry*, pray for the economic recovery of the city—that jobs would be created and the current government would be wise in the implementation of reforms; pray for continuing freedom for Christian witness and missionary activity and that Christians would have a vision for evangelizing the Muslim majority, for the Gospel to penetrate three dominant Muslim peoples (the Maninka, the Fula, and the Susu). Pray for unity and cooperation among missions agencies and national churches. In *Tunis* pray that God would reveal his holiness and that the Tunisians will be convicted of sin and come to him. Pray against the strongholds that bring about child sacrifice, against the power of materialism and complacency. Pray that God would use economic hardship to draw Tunisians to himself. Pray

that the government would ease its strict controls, allowing individuals the freedom to investigate the Gospel.


- Pray for Amman and Kuwait City, these great Middle Eastern cities. Pray for Amman, for continued peace with Israel, allowing more opportunities for fellowship and ministry with churches in the West Bank. Pray for ministry to the Palestinian refugees who are experiencing poverty and unemployment. Pray for camp ministries among the youth of the city and that many would hear and respond to the Gospel. Pray that godly leaders will be raised up to serve growing churches and for their financial support. Pray for fruit from the Bibles and literature that is dispersed from this great city. Pray that the previous war in *Kuwait* City will continue to lead Muslims to question Islam's teaching about life after death and that many would turn to the true Resurrection and life. Pray for emotional rebuilding among the families torn apart by violence. Pray for strength and boldness for Kuwaiti believers, that the emir will grant full freedom of worship and witness to them, and for the establishment of an indigenous church. Pray that Kuwaiti resources will be used to advance the Kingdom instead of propagating Islam and persecuting believers.
- Pray for *Bishkek* and *Male*. Pray that the residual occultism, shamanism, and demonic possession in the culture of *Bishkek* will be broken. Pray for the Kyrgyz church–for unity among the immigrant, ethnic Christians, and that it would be indigenous and led by godly leaders. Pray for outside workers to make Jesus plain in the context of the Kyrgyz culture and pray for the distribution of the Kyrgyz New Testament and other Christian media. Pray for *Male*, that tentmakers will be able to work in the city and that Christian expatriates will have wisdom in sharing the Gospel with the city's residents. Pray that Bibles and Christian literature may be imported and that Bibles in the Dhivehi script will become available. Pray that

anti-conversion laws will be changed and that suspicion and prejudice against Christianity might be removed, ending restrictions against Christian media so the Gospel may be heard.

Intercede on behalf of eight of the inner cities of America, (San Francisco, CA; Charlotte-Gastonia-Rock Hill, NC-SC; New Haven-Meriden, CT; Birmingham, AL; Louisville, KY; San Jose, CA; Las Vegas, NV-AZ; Tucson, AZ; Jacksonville, FL) that the Holy Spirit might ignite fresh movements of vital spirituality and missions outreach in these cities.

City Significance/History:
This ancient city dates back to the 4th millennium bc. In the Old Testament it is known as the Ammonite city of Rabbah. King David sent Uriah to this city to die in battle to cover David's sin with Bathsheba. At the city's capture David completely destroyed the inhabitants by having them walk through an extremely hot furnace. David was, in some way, following a local custom. For Molech, a deity to whom parents sacrificed their children by having them walk into or pass through a fiery kiln, was the god of the Ammonites.

As a fortified city in almost desert conditions, water is extremely important to life. Carayans of traders would pass through the city, exchanging goods and replenishing water. The city grew slowly over the seven hills of the area. The population exploded when it became the capital of Jordan in this century. Once a major hub of ancient travelers, it continues to be a crossroad in Jordan

Jordan maintains the sacred Muslim shrines in Jerusalem and paid millions to regild the Dome of the Rock in 1994. Peace talks with Israel have reopened borders between the two nations. King Hussein's American-born wife helps him maintain close ties with the West.

Prayer Points
1. Pray for the important work of Bible and literature distribution. Christian literature is sent from here throughout the Middle East.

- 2. Pray that the youth of the city (50% of the population is under the age of 15) will have the chance to hear and respond to the gospel. Pray that the camp ministries for these youth will bring many into the kingdom.
- 3. Pray for continued peace with Israel, which will allow more opportunities for fellowship and ministry with churches in the West Bank
- 4. Pray that godly and willing leaders will be raised up to serve growing churches and that finances to support
- 5. Because of the war, 400,000 Palestinians fled to Amman from the Gulf. Pray for ministry to this group which is experiencing poverty and unemployment.

City Significance/History:
Jinan is often referred to as the city of springs, a reference to its 102 natural springs. Their source is the Lake of Great Purity outside the city. Huge dikes protect the city from the Yellow River's periodic flooding. The Shanghai to Beijing railway runs through Jinan, providing income and trade.

India

In China there are two main distinctions in the church: the Three Self Patriotic Movement (TSPM) and the house church movement. The TSPM is government-controlled and makes worshippers officially register. Because of the government affiliation with this church, many feel they have sold their souls to the enemy. There is no doubt the government places pastors in the TSPM churches, but true believers do exist in it.

In the last few years, a TSPM seminary has opened in Jinan. Chinese Christians do desire to be trained in leading the church. Over 200 people applied for the 54 openings at the seminary. Around 60% of the curriculum is considered biblical, 40% nonbiblical. Where the Word of God is restricted, prayers need to flow that the 60% would be a sharp two-edged sword.

- Prayer Points

 1. The government has begun to allow Bibles to be printed in China, most of which go to the spiritually hungry believers in the TSPM churches. Pray that these Bibles will produce a great harvest and true worshippers.
- 2. Pray for the TSPM seminary. May God use this building and these students to increase his name and glory in all of China. Pray for biblical teaching and training.
- 3. Pray that residents of this city of springs may come to know the source of the real Living Water, who brings true righteousness and purity
- 4. Pray for spiritual revival in this educational and industrial center
- 5 Tai Shan, one of China's five sacred mountains, rises 100 kilometers south of the city. Pray that the spiritual power behind this stronghold would be broken.

City Significance/History:
From a small desert oasis making money from pearls and other traded goods, Kuwait City exploded as an oil producer. Five gates made entrance into the walled city possible. These walls, once protecting it from invasion, have crumbled. The city has expanded past the old walls, but invaders still attack.

Oil wealth has turned Kuwait into one of the world's richest countries. Schooling, electricity, and water are all free to the Kuwalitis. Iraq's desire for more oil, supposedly to share it with poorer countries, was their justification for military invasion in 1990-91. When the Iraqis were driven out, Kuwait City was free once again. The oil fields were ablaze with 500 wells burning out of control. Black haze blocked the noonday sun. The Persian Gulf was full of oil.

Now the fires have been put out and the city cleaned, but the fear and horror of those days remain in the hearts of the people.

The rebuilding of the city and the return to a normal life has been one of the government's central concerns. Damage to government and historical buildings was extremely high. The physical damage is being repaired, but the people's lives will continue to be affected by the memories of the war.

- 1. Since the war physical rebuilding has started; however, emotional rebuilding comes more slowly. Pray for the families torn apart in the violence, as many lost relatives.
- 2. The war caused many Muslims to question Islam's teaching about life after death. Pray that many would turn to the Resurrection and the Life
- 3. Pray for strength and boldness for Kuwaiti believers and for the establishment of an indigenous church.
- 4. Pray that the emir will grant full freedom of worship and witness to Kuwaiti and indigenous believers
- 5. Pray that Kuwaiti money will never again be used to propagate Islam by building mosques, burning Bibles, and paying for Islamic conversions.

City Significance/History:
Conakry began as a small fishing village on Tomba Island and has since developed into the country's main port, educational center, and capital.

After independence from France in 1958, Guinea embraced Marxist ideology. Christians suffered greatly under the Marxist pro-Islamic government. The city went into decline, with the infrastructure almost completely collapsing. The streets became extremely dirty, with garbage everywhere.

A military coup in 1984 overthrew the Marxist regime and restored basic freedoms. The military government has been struggling to bring recovery and economic progress since entering power. The city's appearance has not improved–changes come slowly. Presently there is religious liberty for Christian witness and missionary activity.

During the rainy season, Conakry may receive as much as 12 feet of rain. Iron and bauxite mining has permitted the city to grow slowly in recent years.

Conakry is struggling to bring economic recovery

Prayer Points

- 1. Pray for the economic recovery of the city-that jobs would be created and that the current government would be wise in the implementation of reforms.
- 2. Pray that freedom for Christian witness and missionary activity would continue.
- 3. Pray for the Christians to have a vision for evangelizing the Muslim majority

City Significance/History:
The massive Tien Shan Mountains separate western China from the steppes of Central Asia. The nomadic Kirghiz living in round yurts (tents) would move seasonally with their herds from the mountains to the flatlands. The mountains forced the trade routes to pass along the foothills, and many people desired to control these routes. The Chinese, other Central Asians, Arabs, and Mongols would storm the region seeking control. For most of the past two millennia, others have ruled the land.

Bishkek, also known as Frunze, was only one of many settlements established along the long Silk Road. From these sites, travelers would journey along the trade route and local peoples would buy and sell goods. One khan would gain control, only to be replaced by another in the continual struggle to control this strategic site

In 1825, a fortress was built along the Chu River valley to protect tax collectors from the Kirghiz Silk Road pirates. The Russians later invaded Central Asia and this small Silk Road fortification was easy prey for them in 1865. Russia established a stronghold and city. While under Soviet control, the area developed as the capital, educational, and economic center for Kyrgyzstan.

Prayer Points

- 1. Pray that the residual occultism, shamanism, and demonic possession in the culture will be broken
- 2. Pray for unity among the immigrant, ethnic Christians. Their divisions have negatively impacted the

City Significance/History:

From its earliest foundations the city has been a place of conflict. Twenty-seven of the temples at one time were dedicated to the god of war-violence was prevalent. As one military campaign after another swept through China, Taiyuan was always in the way. Almost every invading force conquered the city.

In the early 1900s, the emperor of China gave an edict that all foreigners should be killed, and the Boxer Rebellion was under way. To carry out the edict, soldiers from the Chinese secret society traveled from city to city killing foreigners, especially the "evil ones"—missionaries.

India

When the troops arrived at Taiyuan, they found a walled city. The gates were closed-trapping everyone when the thoops animed at Tarylant, they found a wailed city. The gates were closed—trapping everyone inside. The troops hunted down and beheaded the evil ones; 130 foreign missionaries were martyred. But the 3,000 member Chinese local church lost even more, as many of them tried to protect the missionaries or wanted to identify with Christ and not the Rebellion. Talyuan is the industrial center of the region, and home to 9 institutes of higher learning. "If one family in a clan is found secretly worshipping the Pig (Christ), it will bring disgrace to all of that clan."

City Significance/History:

Tunis originally sprang up as a Phoenician trading post nearly 3000 years ago. The ancient Carthaginian Empire was centered in Carthage—now an archaeological site outside Tunis. Child sacrifice was practiced by the people to worship Baal. Among the ruins a graveyard for children and an altar where children were sacrificed have been unearthed. On the Bougarneen mountain outside of Tunis it is reported that child sacrifice still takes place.

After Carthage was destroyed by the Romans in 146 bc, Tunis grew as a Roman, Byzantine, and finally an Arab city. In 1962 French rule ended

The government of Tunisia has been fighting to keep the country out of the hands of the Islamic fundamentalist group Ennahdha. They have even placed some of its more radical members in prison, charging them with treason. Unemployment and a sluggish economy have not helped the government, but they are seeking to enhance trade with industrialized nations. Tunis has been the headquarters for the Arab league and the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO). It was Yasir Arafat's home and where the PLO gave leadership to the Palestinians when the group was outlawed in Israel.

Prayer Points
1. Pray against the spirit of materialism which strongly grips the people's hearts. Individually and nationally the highest priority is peace and prosperity.

- 2. Lift before the Lord the child sacrifice situation-asking him to remove whatever spiritual strongholds might
- 3. Pray that God would use economic hardships to draw Tunisians to himself
- 4. Pray for unity in the small Christian community and against complacency, for life is comfortable.



City Significance/History:
Little is known about the ancient history of Male. It is believed that the small island nation of the Maldives was founded by sailors from India, Sri Lanka, and other countries.

It is likely that the people worshiped the sun as their god, with beliefs also in evil spirits. Because most of the It's likely trial the people worshiped the sun as their god, with beliefs and on it evin spirits. Decause most of a 1192 Islands are only a meter or two above sea level, ancient temple sites have been converted into mosques. Most mosques in the world are built with their main wall facing Mecca; in the Maldives when the Muslims pray, they face the corner of the mosque because the old foundations face the sun.

Islam entered the country in the 12th century when Arab and North African merchants established control. By the 16th century, the Portuguese desired more influence in the East Indian trade, and built a fort at Male. They replaced the existing Muslim sultan and expanded their dominance. The sultan's followers rebelled and massacred the Portuguese

The sultan firmly established Islam as the state religion, and Islam has continued to be the only religion of the area. Male has been a territory protected by other rulers, but never completely controlled by outside powers.
