2 Let God Arise! Seasonal Prayer Focus / The Season after Epiphany: The Manifestation of Christ, 2012

Lord, Your Kingdom Has Come: The Already/Not Yet Kingdom and Urban Ministry

Greetings, mighty prayer warriors of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!

This month we reflect on Mark 1.14-20 and the biblical concept of the Already/Not Yet Kingdom of God. According to the Scriptures, with the entrance of Jesus into the world, the Kingdom of God is at hand.

Our text in Mark 1.14-20 (ESV) reads:

¹⁴Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, ¹⁵and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." ¹⁶Passing alongside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. ¹⁷And Jesus said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men." ¹⁸And immediately they left their nets and followed him. ¹⁹And going on a little farther, he saw James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, who were in their boat mending the nets. ²⁰And immediately he called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired servants and followed him.

With the coming of Jesus into the world the time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand. Jesus, who came in the fullness of time (Gal. 4.6-7), is the Incarnation of the Messiah, the Word who became flesh, and the reign and rule of God has become manifest in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. God's authority and rule has become revealed in his person, exhibited in his works, and interpreted through his teaching and testimony.

In a wonderful little book entitled *Is the Kingdom of God Realism?*, E. Stanley Jones, says "Jesus' message was the Kingdom of God. It was the

center and circumference of all He taught and did. . . . The Kingdom of God is the master-conception, the master-plan, the master-purpose, the master-will that gathers everything up into itself and gives it redemption, coherence, purpose, goal."

Yes, indeed, the idea of the Kingdom of God coming to earth is a vital concept in biblical theology, and its present and future sense is clearly argued in scholarly works like Oscar Cullman's *Christ and Time*, and the various works of George Eldon Ladd, i.e., *The Gospel of the Kingdom*. The concept is both basic and biblical. First, the Kingdom is *already present*: at Messiah's first advent, the rebellious prince was bound and his house looted, and God's reign has come. Nevertheless, the Kingdom is *not yet consummated*: at Messiah's second advent, the rebellious prince will be destroyed and his rule confounded, with the full manifestation of God's kingly power in a recreated heaven and earth.

In Jesus' life, passion, death, and resurrection he displays the glory and victory of the Crucified King, who came to destroy the devil's work, to make atonement for sin, and to reveal the Father's heart of love for his creation and humankind. In his first coming Christ has conquered, he has become as the ancients said, "Christus Victor", Christ the Victor, the Conqueror of the devil, the Lord of Glory, and the reigning King of heaven.

Truly this is the distinctiveness of Jesus' gospel proclamation, i.e., that "The Kingdom is at hand" (Mark 1.14-15). Now in Jesus of Nazareth, his life, works, presence on earth in the Incarnation, the Kingdom of God has come to earth, not fully, but truly, with the life and power of the Age to Come having invaded and come into this present age (John 1.1-18). John the Baptist is the forerunner of the King (Matt. 11.2-6) and Jesus inaugurated his messianic ministry at his synagogue in Nazareth (Luke 4.16-21). In his ministry of exorcisms he confronted the demonic forces (Luke 10.18ff.; 11.20), and he claimed the Father gave him absolute authority on earth to

forgive sin (Mark 2.1-12; Matt. 21.27; 28.18). In Jesus' life and work the Kingdom has come and the strong man is bound (Matt. 12.28, 29); the actual presence of God's Kingdom is now manifest on earth in the Church of Jesus Christ (Eph. 2.19-22).

Paul Billheimer, in his *Destined for the Throne* (p. 87) highlights the victory Christ won through the Cross:

Christ's death for our sins — His payment of the penalty declared against us — was His legal victory whereby He erased Satan's legal claim to the human race. But Christ also won dynamic victory. That is, when He was justified and made alive, adjudged and declared righteous in the Supreme Court of the universe, Satan, the arch foe of God and man, was completely disarmed and dethroned. Christ burst forth triumphantly from that age-old prison of the dead. Paul says that He "spoiled principalities and powers" and "made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it" (Colossians 2.15)."

In every thing our Lord did he demonstrated the present rule of the Kingdom of God come to earth. Check out my rudimentary list of his works and their meaning vis-a-vis the Kingdom of God:

- 1. His mission: to destroy the works of the devil, 1 John 3.8
- 2. His birth: the invasion of God into Satan's dominion, Luke 1.31-33
- 3. His *message*: the Kingdom's proclamation and inauguration, Mark 1.14-15
- 4. His *teaching*: kingdom ethics, Matt. 5-7
- 5. His *miracles*: his kingly authority and power, Mark 2.8-12
- 6. His exorcisms: his defeat of the devil and his angels, Luke 11.14-20
- 7. His *life and deeds*: the majesty of the Kingdom, John 1.14-18
- 8. His resurrection: the victory and vindication of the King, Rom. 1.1-4
- 9. His commission: the call to global kingdom mission, Matt. 28.18-20

- 10. His ascension: his coronation, Heb.1.2-4
- 11. His Spirit: the arrabon (surety, pledge) of the Kingdom, 2 Cor. 1.20
- 12. His Church: the foretaste and agent of the Kingdom, 2 Cor. 5.18-21
- 13. His *session in heaven*: the generalship of God's forces, 1 Cor.15.24-28
- 14. His *Parousia* (*Second Coming*): the final consummation of the Kingdom, Rev. 17

Yes, with the arrival of Jesus into the world, the Kingdom of God has come! George Ladd lays out the phases of God's kingdom rule in *The Gospel of the Kingdom* (p. 50):

God's Kingdom means the divine conquest over His enemies, a conquest which is to be accomplished in three stages; and the first victory has already occurred. The power of the Kingdom of God has invaded the realm of Satan-the present evil Age. The activity of this power to deliver men from satanic rule was evidenced in the exorcism of demons. Thereby, Satan was bound; he was cast down from his position of power; his power was "destroyed." The blessings of the Messianic Age are now available to those who embrace the Kingdom of God. We may already enjoy the blessings resulting from this initial defeat of Satan. This does not mean that we enjoy the fullness of God's blessings, or that all that is meant by the Kingdom of God has come to us.... the Second Coming of Christ is absolutely essential for the fulfillment and consummation of God's redemptive work. Yet God has already accomplished the first great stage in His work of redemption. Satan is the god of This Age, yet the power of Satan has been broken that men may know the rule of God in their lives.

The implications of the Already/Not Yet Kingdom are far reaching for us who seek to advance his Kingdom in the city through ministry and mercy:

First, the power of Satan has been broken in this current world through the life and victory of Jesus Christ, the Conqueror of death, hell, and the grave. Second, Christians are the ambassadors and agents of Christ and his kingdom, with local congregations serving as outposts and colonies of the Already/Not Yet Kingdom of God. Third, Prayer is, as John Piper suggests, the walkie-talkie of God on the battlefields on earth where the souls and lives of the unreached are being waged over. Through consistent, believing, and fervent intercessory prayer we can call down the power of heaven to the dark, shadowy places of earth, and see God's weapons of light dispel the powers of evil in the lives of people. Last of all, with the vast majority of human beings now living in cities, we can know that the cities of the world are central venues for the struggle for souls and the advance of the Kingdom in our time. We must struggle, wrestle, pray, and believe God for revival for the cities of the world.

Give yourself without reserve to advancing the already/not yet Kingdom of God in the neighborhood and city where you live. For only if God arises can your community be won for the Nazarene who is now Christ the Victor, the Lord of heaven and earth.

Global Strategic Vision

Pray fervently and in faith for the following *Gateway Cities in the* 10/40 *Window*. Ask the Lord of the harvest to multiply the laborers in these difficult fields, to bring explicit unity and harmony among believers within them, and to demonstrate with power the truth of the Word through signs and wonders of the Holy Spirit.

- Northern Africa: Asmara and Cotonou
- Middle East: Cairo and Doha
- Central Asia: Hyderabad and Thimphu
- Eastern Asia: Lanzhou and Tokyo-Yokohama

Pray fervently for these great cities, supplicating on their behalf before the Lord, asking him to pour out his own dear Holy Spirit upon them, that *God would be God in each of them*, and that the *gospel of the Kingdom would penetrate every dimension of these societies within each of these influential Gateway cities*. Let us entreat the Lord on behalf of them, key cities, believing God for his intervention:

• Pray for an outpouring of God's Holy Spirit within *Asmara* and *Cotonou*, that God would bring unity with the Coptic Orthodox and Evangelical churches in *Asmara*, for inroads and change among the Muslim peoples there, and for finances to underwrite new initiatives for the gospel; pray for *Cotonou*, for those families and clans deeply affected by the slave trade that was once prosperous there, pray for deliverance against the entrenched traditional religions, animism and voodoo practiced within the city; pray for the mighty power of God to show signs and wonders confirming the Kingdom proclamation regarding Messiah Jesus, and for continued growth in the church of *Cotonou*, and the pastors who shepherd them.

- Pray for *Cairo* and *Doha*, these great Middle Eastern cities. Pray for *Cairo*, for innovative new ways for the gospel to be presented to the Muslims, most of whom are poor, pray for the students at El Azhar, the largest Muslim university in the world, pray for the salvation of its leaders, pray for clarity for these Muslim leaders and missionaries, so they can know that Jesus is the Messiah, pray for the Coptic church and the few evangelical churches, and for a new generation of zealous believers to be raised up in Cairo for Egypt and witness through the Arab world. Pray for *Doha*, for a new, strong indigenous church made up of native peoples, for effective evangelism among the expatriates there, for open doors to use radio and video in outreach for Christ, for the students at Quatar University, that they could be reached with the gospel of Jesus.
- Pray for *Hyderabad* and *Thimphu*, that the minds of believers in *Hyderabad* would be renewed, illumined, strengthened in the Word of God, for new forms of cross-cultural evangelism to blossom; pray for the effective witness among the Christian agencies, institutions, and teachers in the city, for the VBS ministries being used to reach households, and for new ways to provide the poor with justice there. Pray for *Thimphu*, that its major religious site and government seat, Taschichlo Dzong, would be illumined by the Holy Spirit so the monks and politicians might hear of the Lord Jesus. Pray for the protection of the Bible translators, and that current translation projects would be completed soon, that this city with its strongly Buddhist population (with less than 200 known believers) would experience an outpouring of the Lord there. Pray for a strong indigenous church to be formed there, and that Christian literature and radio would be permitted in the official languages spoken there.

Pray for Lanzhou and Tokyo-Yokohama, for these influential great Eastern Asian cities. Pray that the gospel of Christ would come to Lanzhou, this desolate region of China, pray for an effective witness among the Hui people (who are Chinese yet culturally Muslim), for a revival and outpouring upon the Chinese solders stationed there, and for the believers there, for their protection from persecution, along with renewed boldness in their witness, and the growth of their church. Pray for Tokyo-Yokohama, pray for the Lord to shake this great commercial and national center, pray for despair and disillusionment among the materialistic culture of the city, pray for confusion among the cultists and other religious groups that are targeting the city (Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, and Moonies, Buddhist-influenced groups, etc.). Pray for the salvation of the Imperial family, for unity and oneness among the various Christian groups there, and for a new awakening of evangelism among that highly populated area, and from there, all over the Japanese nation.

National Strategic Window

Intercede on behalf of eight of the inner cities of America, (*Norfolk-Virginia Beach-Newport News, VA-NC; Seattle-Bellevue-Everett, WA; Sacramento, CA; Kansas City, MO-KS; Cincinnati, OH-KY-IN; El Paso, TX; Fort Worth-Arlington, TX; Milwaukee-Waukesha, WI; McAllen-Edinburg-Mission, TX) that the Holy Spirit might ignite fresh movements of vital spirituality and missions outreach in these cities.*

- Pray for *revival among God's people who live in these cities*, that *God would be God in each of them*, that pastors and Christians within them will feel again the urgency and power of the Holy Spirit to win the lost around them, and feel the burden of being custodians of God's true Word.

Major Religious Sites: Anwar Mosque

City Significance/History: At the edge of a high plateau rests Asmara, once a beautiful Italian-built city, and now one of the newest capitals in the world. A large university was founded here in 1958.

Sudan

Ethiopia claimed Eritrea as part of the Ethiopian Empire. Over the last 31 years, Eritrea has sought independence from Ethiopia through violence and political wars. Drought and war led to a famine that killed many

In 1993, independence was granted and a new country was formed. The beautiful Italian city was marred by machine guns and mortars

Now that rain has started to fall and war is over, reconstruction of the land is beginning. Roads destroyed in the war are being patched, and crops have grown. In the last few years, they have been able to double crop production, allowing for a reduction in foreign aid.

Having fought and died together has allowed the Muslims and Christians to work together towards building a new country. Dropping ethnic differences has also permitted stability and a national identity that in many other countries is falling apart.

Prayer Points

1. Pray for the continued economic recovery of the city and country-that rain would continue to water the crops

2. Coptic Orthodox and Evangelical Christians have been meeting and even having all night prayer times together. Praise God for this unity that persecution has brought. Pray that revival will enter these churches.

3. Pray for Muslim converts among the Tigre, Afar, Beja, and Saho peoples

4. Pray for Christian missionaries to return and to serve the church with leadership training, media, and helping ministries.

5. Pray for finances to enable churches to rebuild and repair facilities damaged by fighting.



Cotonou (koh-teh-noo) Day 4

Meaning: unknown Country: Benin* Population: 501,000 Poverty: Growing economic opportunities with the fall of communism Religious Breakdown: 50.0% Animist 20.0% Muslim 28.2% Christian (mainly Catholic) 1.96% Evangelical

Status of the church: (including Porto Novo) 17 evangelical with 4000 members, 60,000 African Independent Church members

Major Religious Sites: Central Mosque

City Significance/History:

Although neighboring Porto Novo is the official capital, most government and diplomatic functions occur in Cotonou. In 1960 Benin received its independence from France. In 1991 democracy replaced the Marxist government that had ruled for over a decade. The cult of voodoo was born in Benin, and it is but one expression of animistic religion keeping people in spiritual bondage.

The countries just south of the Sahara Desert were the nearest place for developing nations to receive cheap slave labor. Thus port cities grew, slave ships came and went, and African families were torn to pieces.

Cotonou was one of the centers for the deportation of slaves. The coast in this area became known as the "Slave Coast."

For those countries responsible for the sin against these African people, this is a day to repent and ask for forgiveness

For those of African heritage, whose ancesters were victims of the slave trade, give the blessing of forgiveness, just as Christ has forgiven.

On this day, millions of people will be praying prayers of repentance and millions will be giving forgiveness. May Christ be glorified!

For those countries who received African slave labor, pray prayers of repentance for the acts of your fathers. Ask God to wipe away any sin that remains.

2. For those families who were victims of the slave trade, give the blessing of forgiveness to the children of those who enslaved your forefathers.

3. God is more powerful than all traditional religions and voodoo practices. Pray that God would reveal his mighty power in Cotonou, and break the hold of animism

4. Pray for workers to reach the unevangelized Muslims who comprise 20% of the urban population.

5. Pray for continued growth in the church and for leaders to be trained as pastors

Cairo (kI-roh) Day 9

Meaning: "the victorious Country: Egypt* Population: 10,361,000 Poverty: Many slums Religious Breakdown: 87.0% Muslim 12.0% Coptic Christians 0.73% Evangelicals

Status of the church: Home of ancient Coptic Church, growing evangelical church

Maior Religious Sites:

Ibn Tulun Mosque, El Ibn el Asn Mosque, Sultan Hassan Mosque, Al Azhar Mosque and University, El Hussein and Sayida Zeynab Tombs

City Significance/History:

The Bible tells of Jesus being taken to Egypt by his family because Herod was seeking to kill him. Tradition says he went to Cairo. After Jesus' resurrection, the old Roman fortress in Cairo became a Christian colony, church, and eventually, convent. The ancient Coptic church also became centered in Cairo.

In the shadows of the ancient pyramids, Cairo rises from the desert floor as the largest city in Africa. Spreading out along the Nile River over the centuries, the river provides life to a desert land. In the spring the desert heat increases. Sand blows and covers the streets of Cairo.

Islam entered the area early after Muhammad's death, and has been a strong force ever since. Al Azhar founded the oldest university in the world-it developed into the foremost Islamic theological center in 970. The crusaders tried to take Cairo by force, returning Christianity to the area, but were successfully turned away by the Muslim defenders.

For the poor, life is hard. Living in overcrowded, run-down slums, millions are all in the same situation-there is no hope and seemingly no way out. They feel stuck and humiliated-yet their religious pride is still not broken

Praver Points


Pray for the gospel to be presented to Muslims (most of whom are poor) in an understandable way and for culturally sensitive churches to be planted.

2. Pray that false worship involving homage to dead Muslim saints would be broken and that people would worship the risen Jesus

3. El Azhar is the largest Islamic university in the world and sends out hundreds of Islamic missionaries annually. Pray that the students would be disillusioned with Islam and turn to Christ.

4. Pray for strong biblical faith in the Coptic and Evangelical churches

5. Pray for zealous Christian young people to be raised up to evangelize Cairo and Egypt. Pray for the few missionaries already being sent out from Egypt.



Iran Bahrain Oatar K Doha Saudi Arabia U.A.E

Major Religious Sites: Grand Mosque

City Significance/History: The expanding desert proved a hard place to live. Bedouins would move from one oasis to another trying to make a living by trading dates and other goods. The coastal areas of the Persian Gulf allowed for a little mo stability, providing food through fishing and a little income by diving for pearls. Doha was settled as these more nomadic Bedouins chose to fish instead of wander the desert.

This small city remained poor and of little interest to the outside world for most of its history. Bahrain and Qatar have fought for the rights to the rich pearl beds, but otherwise, little importance was given to Doha, the country's capital. The British, a protector of Qatar until its independence in 1971, did not even have a representative in the country until after oil was found.

Just before World War II, Qatar was found to be oil rich. Ten years passed until oil production began. The whole country started to prosper because of the wealth of the black gold. The country also has some of the world's largest gas reserves. The pearl beds have dried up, but now oil rights have been the center of political squabbles between Bahrain and Qatar.

Prayer Points
1. Pray that some nonresident Qatari believers may return home and become the core of an indigenous church.

2. Pray that the emir would lift legal prohibitions against evangelizing Muslims.

3. Pray that the expatriate Christians working in Doha may be fruitful in their friendship evangelism.

Pray that evangelism utilizing radio and video might touch many lives.

5. Pray that the materialistic lifestyle produced by the great oil wealth would bring disillusionment and a renewed search for spiritual truth in Jesus.

6. Pray that students at Qatar University might be reached with the gospel.

Hvderabad (hi-der-uh-bahd) Day 18

Meaning: "lion town" Country: India, Andhra Pradesh Province* Population: 4,208,000 Poverty: Many slums Religious Breakdown: 85.5% Hindu 8.47% Muslim 2.9% Christian 1.0% Evangelical

Status of the church: 134 churches from different denominations

Major Religious Sites: Birla Mandir Hindu Temple, Mecca Masjid Mosque, Charminar Mosque Mahan Kali Temple

City Significance/History:

Hinduism was replaced by Islam, only for Hinduism to regain control again–one spiritual power rising against another. As Islamic Mongols gained power in the north, they sought to control India's south. Islamic raiding parties went to Golkonda to capture it. The solid stone walls of its citadel held off the warriors for 8 months, but finally fell to the Mongol forces.

The citadel increased and expanded in the 16th century to create a new city, Hyderabad. Hyderabad became a regional center for Islam and seat of the wealthy Nizam (ruler) of Hyderabad. The Nizam ruled the area from the 18th century until the British displaced their rule.

In 1947 independence was granted to India by the British. The Nizam tried to gain control again by calling for an independent Islamic territory. But 85% of the city's population was Hindu at the time, and the Indian government in Delhi did not want a separate Islamic state within India.

Today Hyderabad has grown, connecting itself with the neighbor city of Secunderabad. Together, this metro area makes it India's sixth largest city. As the provincial capital, it is also home for one of the largest Christian populations in India.

Praver Points

Pray that the minds of believers would be renewed, so that unbiblical thinking that has persisted in the traditional Christian community would cease

2. Pray that the believers would become involved in cross-cultural evangelism and for a harvest among the largely unreached Muslims

3. Pray that the Christian agencies, institutions, and teachers here would have a great spiritual impact on the city

4. Vacation Bible Schools are being used to reach children. Pray for many children and parents to come to Christ.

5. Many beggars are in the city. Pray for them to come to Christ and to find work.

Status of the church: A few small fellowships

Major Religious Sites:

Tashichho Dzong, Chang Ganka Monastery, Cheri Monastery

City Significance/History: All throughout the Himalayas flags and other pieces of cloth wave in the wind as Buddhist prayers continue to be offered by the moving cloths. This small Buddhist country with its largest city and capital, Thimphu, has been left alone throughout history.

During the British occupation of India, British diplomats came through Thimphu seeking permission to move goods from Tibet through Bhutan into India. For periods of time there was no problem being part of this trade route. After the English left and China entered Tibet, Bhutan became a hidden country with Buddhist temples and monasteries dotting the mountains.

In Thimphu is the largest Buddhist center in the country, Tashichho Dzong. The name translates something close to "the fort of the glorious religion." Dzongs are found throughout the country. One half of the building is dedicated to Buddhism and religion; the other half is used as a civil administration center. From Tashichho, all the civil and Buddhist administration is carried out for the whole country. It is also from here that the government is run. The king's ornate throne room is here, along with a Buddhist monastery.

Prayer Points 1. Tashichho Dzong is the power center of the country, administrating both religion and government. Pray that God would be known by the monks and political leaders.

Pray that the king would be favorable to Christianity and grant freedom to witness and worship. Pray that tentmakers could work without restrictions.

3. Pray for the protection of Bible translators and that translations into Dzongkha, Kebumtamp, and Sharchagpakha would be completed.

4. The Drukpa majority is strongly Buddhist with less than 200 known believers. Pray for a dynamic indigenous church to be raised up

Little Christian literature and no radio programming is available in the official Dzongkha language. Pray for the development of these essential tools.

Lanzhou (lan-jow) Day 22

Meaning: "the fragrant city" Country: China, Gansu Province * Population: 1,803,000 Poverty: One of the poorest areas in China Religious Breakdown: 59.1% Nonreligious/Atheist 30.1% Chinese Religions 1.4% Muslim 6.1% Christian 5.0% Evangelical

Status of the church: TSPM church at Zhangye Road (see Jinan for TSPM explanation)

Major Religious Sites: White Pagoda, Temple of the Town Gods, Blingisi Buddhist Caves

City Significance/History: Dust rises and blows over the city from the arid desert that runs from Lanzhou into Inner Mongolia. This haze, mixed with industrial pollution, covers the city-the capital of one of China's poorest provinces

For historic traders crossing the desert, oasis villages provided stepping stones on their way from places as far away as Rome to find the valuable silk of the East. Lanzhou has been a crossroads city from the beginning. The trade routes went in all directions, bringing unusual travelers through the city. Silk went west with travelers, Buddhism was brought up from the south.

Lining the Yellow River, Lanzhou developed as a railroad link for goods going to other places, but it has now been transformed into an industrial center for northwest China

The Yellow River provides water to desert-like, but extremely fertile land. Crops of melons and fruits keep most of the population working, but in recent years China's atomic energy industry has been based in Lanzhou

China's atomic energy industry headquarters

Praver Points

Pray for the gospel to come in power to this desolate desert region of China which is spiritually barren as well.


2. Pray for Christian teachers and workers to come to this city, which has low literacy levels and a high poverty rate

3. Pray for a witness to the Hui people, who are ethnically Chinese but culturally Muslim, and that their traditional resistance to the gospel will be broken down

4. Pray for the Holy Spirit to move among the Chinese soldiers who make up a large percentage of the population

5. Pray that the leaders in this provincial capital would not persecute believers and hinder the growth of the church







Industries were built and the city grew.

Today Tokyo and Yokohama make up one of the greatest metropolitan mega-cities in the world. The population has continued to increase and more land has been reclaimed from rivers and the ocean. Tokyo is home to the Japanese Parliament and the powerful Ministry of International Trade and Industry

Prayer Points

1. Pray for God to shake the city and nation. The biggest barrier to the gospel is a sense that it is irrelevant to people, as almost all are materially satisfied. A spirit of materialism motivates this global economic center.

2. Pray against the rise and influence of cults like Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, and Moonies, as well as new Buddhist-influenced religious movements

3. Prayer for the salvation of the Imperial family and that official visits to the Yasokuni Shrine by politicians will be discontinued.

Pray for unity and mutual understanding between non-charismatic and charismatic Christians. Suspicion has led to lack of cooperation and spiritual pride.

Pray for Japanese believers to engage in personal evangelism and not just invite friends to church meetings-this could lead to significant church growth.

Tokyo-Yokohama

Status of the church: T-922, Y-465

Maior Religious Sites: T-Yasukuni and Meiji Shrines, Kwannon and Kaneiji Temples, Y-Asakusa Amanawa Shrines, Great Buddha Statue, Hasedera Temple

City Significance/History: About 500 years ago, fishers and rice farmers lived in the small village of Edo. Three rivers joined there, but very little took place in this sleepy village. A fort was built in the mid-16th century to protect the military Shogun (Takugawa) capital. With time, the marshy lowlands were reclaimed and the city expanded. The Shogun rule turned Japan's economy from the wealth of the aristocracy into a commercial state. Edo continued to grow and develop, until the 18th century when it hit one million people-the largest city of the time

As Edo grew, foreigners desired greater contact with the city. The Takugawa government did not want the foreigners in Edo, so they allowed the fishing settlement of Yokohama to house the international community. The development of this port city allowed for foreign trade and technology to increase throughout Japan.
