The Master and Laborers of the Vineyard: Equal Pay for Equal Work?

In his parable of the laborers in the vineyard (Matt. 20.1-16), Jesus compared the Kingdom of heaven to a master of a house who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard. He contracted each laborer for his wage, and granted to each according to his contract. As lord of the harvest, he determined the blessing and remuneration, not the workers; he determines the reward and the blessing to all.

Our God is large-hearted, generous with the things that belong to him, open-handed and open-hearted to all the laborers who are called to work in the vineyard of his mission. What may seem surprising to us is that he is Lord over every dimension of the work: those who are hired, the results of the harvest, and the pay that the workers receive. He can hire whomever he wills at whatever time he chooses, and pay them wages based on his generous spirit. We ought neither begrudge his generosity nor overstep our bounds. In every dimension, the work of winning the world lies in the hand of the Lord of the harvest, who himself is working all things out for us and the world according to his will.

Global Strategic Vision

Pray fervently and in faith for the following *Gateway Cities in the 10/40 Window*. Ask the Lord Jesus to manifest himself to these great cities through the Holy Spirit, through dreams, miracles, preaching, missions outreaches, and any other ways he elects to reveal his presence through manifestations of the Holy Spirit. Pray that those few who know the Lord in these cities may recover the truth of God's word in such a way as to redouble their efforts of evangelism, discipleship, and church planting. Ask God to make them fruitful and effective in every way in every place:



• Middle East: Jerusalem and Muscat

• Central Asia: Lucknow and Varanasi

• Eastern Asia: Guangzhou and Shanghai

Intercede for these great cities, asking the Father to pour his Holy Spirit upon them, that *Jesus and his Kingdom would become clear within these influential Gateway cities*. Ask the Father for a clear vision of Jesus within these eight key global centers, for laborers, witness, conversion, and mission in Jesus' name:

- Pray for *Banjul* and *Nouakchott*, that the churches would touch the Islamic fundamentalists, for freedom to proclaim the Gospel among them, for outbreaks of the Spirit among the *Mandingo* of Roots fame.
- Pray for the peace of Jerusalem, that the Jewish people would awaken to their need for Messiah Jesus, that they would believe the Old Testament witness about him, and be drawn to him as Lord and Messiah, that believing Arabs and Jews would display the love of Messiah openly and clearly.

- Pray for *the Spirit's outpouring upon Muscat*, that the few indigenous believers would be empowered, and that new churches would be planted, that radio and literature outreaches would be effective, that Muslims would come to Jesus and openly confess him as Lord.
- LET GOD ARISE!
- Pray for *Lucknow* and *Varanasi*, that these great Central Asian cities and their Muslim and Hindu populations would have a spirit of humility and revelation given to them about Messiah, that faith in Messiah would reconcile these peoples, for laborers to arise from the tiny number of believers within them, that renewal and power would come upon the believers, and that the Holy Spirit would demonstrate the power of the Gospel in the midst of the many peoples within them.
- Pray for *Guangzhou* and *Shanghai*, that the house churches that have been harassed in Guangzhou would be protected and empowered in their witness of Messiah, and given freedom to minister in his name in the city, that God would raise up laborers, pastors, and workers for the believers there, for the university students in Shanghai and their openness to the Lord, for deliverance from decadence, love of money there, and for new evangelical churches among the large numbers of seekers in Shanghai. Pray that the Holy Spirit would move the government officials to allow greater freedom for Christian witness and presence in both cities, and that the kingdom hope would be embraced by many, many people in them.

National Strategic Window

Seek the face of the Lord, asking for grace and intervention on behalf of these eight cities of America, (*Riverside*, *CA; Dallas, Atlanta, San Diego*, *Phoenix*, *Washington D.C.*, *Cleveland*, *St. Louis*, *Orange County*, *CA;* and *New Orleans*). Please intercede fervently, asking the Lord to provide them with churches, pastors, prophets, apostles, teachers, and leaders who will prophetically declare the truth of Christ and his Kingdom with power, and that God would enable them to preach with conviction the good news of deliverance to the broken and captive. Finally, pray that God would bless and restore his people in these cities, reviving them for his glory, and that such revival would greatly impact the poorest of the poor in these great cities.

- Pray for *revival among God's people who live in these cities*, that pastors and Christians within them will feel again the urgency and power of the Holy Spirit to win the lost around them, and feel the burden of being custodians of God's true Word.
- Pray that God would pour out his power and grace upon the *believers in these cities in such a way that new and fresh testimonies of the truth in Jesus* would be given in neighborhoods that rarely, if ever, hear of the victorious reign of God in Jesus, and his offer to cleanse the repentant through his shed blood. Pray that God would raise up ministries, churches, and individuals who will prophetically declare the lordship of Christ and the hope of his Kingdom throughout the structures of the city, the government, the neighborhoods, and the community.
- Above all this season, pray for an outpouring and visitation of the Holy Spirit upon the churches in these cities, especially upon those who minister the Good News of Christ among the least evangelized in these communities. Pray that God would raise up men and women who are unafraid to speak boldly and persuasively the story of God in Scripture, and that God would revive his people to obey God's mandate to make disciples in these cities, with the result that many new churches might be planted among the poor in these cities.

Meaning: "bamboo island" Country: Gambia* Population: 560,000 Poverty: Subsistence living for many Religious Breakdown: 95.4% Muslim 2.1% Christian (mainly Catholic) 0.19% Evangelical

Status of the church: Anglican and Methodist churches

Major Religious Sites: New Banjul Central Mosque

City Significance/History:
Banjul was nothing more than a cluster of mud huts until the need for slave labor arose in more developed countries. The British changed this village into a large trading post.

Alex Haley's book *Roots* traced Kunta Kinte's homeland to Gambia. It was in the village of Juffure where he was captured and taken to the port of Banjul for transport to North America.

Banjul, located at the mouth of the Gambia River, became a destination where slaves were transported. The 700-mile-long river allowed slave traders to capture slaves far inland and transport them easily for auction and deportation in Banjul. Once on the ships, they went to slave plantations throughout the world.

Today Banjul, technically an island, has been connected to the mainland by a bridge. Its location has caused it to be demographically stagnant for years, and this has hurt the economy. However, the mainland suburbs around Banjul have recently experienced rapid growth.

Prayer Points

- 5. Prison ministry has produced many converts. Pray for more conversions and the reintegration of released prisoners into churches and communities.
- 6. Pray that the three Sufi brotherhoods would come to base their fellowship in the Holy Spirit.

City Significance/History:

This holy city is the focal point of the three monotheistic religions—Juda-ism, Christianity, and Islam. It dates to Abraham's meeting with Melchizedek, the king of Salem, in Genesis 14. Mount Moriah, outside the city, was where Abraham offered his son Isaac on the altar, before God provided the lamb. (Muslims say that it was Ishmael, not Isaac.) Years later, Jesus was crucified outside Jerusalem.

King David built the city as the capital. His son Solomon built the first Jewish temple, later destroyed by the Babylonians in 586 bc. A second temple was built by Zerubbabel and enlarged by Herod the Great. Jesus prophesied its destruction, and in ad 70 the Romans took it apart stone by stone.


Muslims dominated the city for nearly 1300 years. It is their third holiest city and the Dome of the Rock was built on the site of the temple mount. The Crusaders briefly ruled during the 12th century. Mamelukes and Ottomans controlled it until the British occupation during World War I. Jerusalem was reunified again under Israeli rule in 1967.

Christian prophetic expectations are focused on this city of peace. Jesus' second coming to the Mount of Olives is yet to be realized in Jerusalem.

Prayer Points

1. Pray that the veil of blindness would be lifted from the Jewish people and that they would believe their own scriptures in the Old Testament

- 2. Pray that God would bond the believing Jews and Arabs together in such love that this would point their
- 3. Pray that the spirit of rabbinic Judaism would be bound as the city is perhaps the greatest stronghold of religious spirits in the world.
- 4. On October 4, the Day of Atonement will be celebrated. Pray for conviction of sin, repentance, and the spirit of grace and supplication to come upon the Jewish people.
- 5. On October 9-17, the Feast of Tabernacles will be celebrated. Pray that God's faithfulness will be remembered as well as his ability to keep Israel through trials.

City Significance/History

Due to its coastal locale and mild climate, this small village of adobe huts was chosen to be the capital of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania in 1960. By 1964 the population (12,300) started to grow and has dramatically increased in the last 30 years.

In Mauritania, a major ethnic line has been drawn. To the north, Arab/Berber Africans make up the majority of the population, and in the south, black Africans live

Northern and southern Africans are being forced from the sahel, the region on the edge of the Sahara Desert, because the ever-enlarging Sahara is drying the sahel, depleting its water sources. Storms blow sand forming dunner that cover the fragile drought-stricken land. Therefore, cities like Nouakchott have to support a fast-growing refugee population.

On the city limit, residents of cardboard shantytowns now make up two-thirds of the total metro population. Overpopulation is causing great deforestation which, in a short time, will result in desertification. Their goats, camels, and cows seek survival in the piles of trash. The desert, with sandstorms 200 days a year, now blows on the streets of Nouakchott, one of the newer capitals in the world.

- Prayer Points
 1. Pray that Islamic *sharia* law would be overturned and for freedom of religion.
- 2. Pray for believers to be strengthened in the face of persecution and possible death. Pray for steadfast,
- 3. Pray for Muslims to convert to the truth of Jesus. They face the death sentence, so much grace and courage is needed to follow the Lord.
- 4. Pray that Christian humanitarian relief to the drought-stricken would show God's love and that the physical needs of the poor would be met.
- 5. Pray for radio broadcasts in Hassaniya (one of the ethnic peoples) Arabic to be produced. Pray for the translation of a Hassaniya Bible and that the 28% literacy level can be raised so people can read it.


City Significance/History:
Muscat has been a strategic seaport city for the last one thousand years. A mud fort, dwarfed by the volcanic
mountains overhead, provided protection for the capital city. The local people would fish, mine lime, or grow
dates as their main income, but the sea was their connection to the outside world.

Sinbad, the famous sailor, sailed from Muscat to exotic places like India and China. He would trade lime, dates, and other goods from the Middle East for rice, coffee, and tea. Other ships would stop here before heading into the Persian Gulf or down the east side of Africa. Because of its location, the Portuguese captured Muscat and set up a regional stronghold in the 1580s. They were later replaced by the Al-Busaid Dynasty, who ruled as far as East Africa. By the mid-17th century, Muscat was back in the hands of the Omani. In 1890 Samuel Zwemer established a medical mission work, which still continues.

Oil found in the desert has brought Muscat into the 20st century. After a palace coup, Sultan Qaboos Bin Said replaced his father as the ruler. The city has grown to include two adjacent cities—Mutrah and Ruwi. Muscat is once again a booming area where oil tankers have replaced the trading ships of old.

- Prayer Points
 1. Pray for strength and boldness for the few indigenous believers, and that churches can be planted.
- 2. Pray that the sultan would allow Omani citizens freedom of religion
- 3. Pray that radio broadcasts and literature distribution would reach the Muslim majority
- 4. Pray that expatriate believers working in the city would show a Christian witness through their lifestyle.
- 5. Pray that ongoing medical missions work would show Christ's love to the people.







City Significance/History:
Varanasi (also known as Banaras or Benares) has been a holy pilgrimage site for over 2000 years. Ten kilometers away at Saranath is where Buddha first preached on enlightenment. Hindus flock the ghats (the wide stairways) that allow them to wash, bathe, and even die in the Ganges River.

Relatives carry their dying loved ones to the river. Laying the frail bodies on one of the lower ghats, they place the feet of the dying into the water. When the person dies, it is believed that they will go straight to heaven. This is important to many Hindus, who believe their dead relatives can come back as evil spirits to haunt them. Along one section of the ghats are the cremation pits. After the body has been cremated, the ashes are sprinkled on the holy Ganges River. Pilgrims will bathe in the holy and polluted Ganges, seeking to be

Many Hindu priests live in Varanasi. As they walk around in deep trances, people seek them for blessings. Gurus have students coming from all over India to sit under their teaching, to meditate, and to learn Sanskrit.

Here the main Hindu god is Shiva, the god of life and death, who has power to kill or to heal

- Pray that this holy city of Hinduism would become filled with the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Pray that the tiny minority of Christians, most of whom are nominal, would experience spiritual strengthening and renewal
- 3. Pray that the millions of pilgrims visiting the Ganges River would find the Living Water given by Jesus
- 4. Hindus here are among the world's most unreached mega-peoples. Pray for workers to labor in this vast harvest field. Pray that the leaflets and Gospels that have been distributed would produce spiritual fruit.
- 5. Pray for a work to be established at the large Hindu university. Little ministry is being done among the

City Significance/History:
The Muslim Mongols established a growing power center in the area. They were replaced by still another

Along the Gomti River arose a small capital city for the Oudh Nawab rulers. These rulers came from a Persian background, not Mongol. From here, the Nawabs controlled north-central India for 100 years. They developed the arts, fine culture, and traditional craftsmanship.

The British annexed the area in the mid-19th century. The backlash from this annexation was an Indian uprising against the 3000-strong British diplomatic presence, including women and children. The Indians far outnumbered the British, who held out for three months in their compound, the Residency of the Nawab rulers. (The Residency was built for the glory of the Nawab rulers.) The Indian onslaught ended when more British troops broke through the Indian lines; however, 2000 of the British were dead.

Today the city—a provincial capital—still has a devoted Islamic population. Shi'ite holy men of the past are believed to have special power if you pray at their graves. Many Muslim people pray for strength and blessings at the tombs of these holy men.

Praver Points

- 1. Pray for growth in the small churches and that new believers can be taught and discipled.
- 2. There is an open door for evangelism at several strategic locations. Pray for a harvest to come from the
- 3. Many East Asian Muslims come here to study. Pray for the establishment of a ministry to them.

City Significance/History:
Shanghai's strategic location marked this unimportant, small weaving and fishing village as one destined to be China's largest city. The flowing Yangtze River meets the Pacific Ocean just south of Shanghai, connecting the city with far western Tibet and other cities in between. Trading has made it the third largest

The British, followed by the French and Japanese, opened the city for their own interests in the 1800s. These foreign entities built autonomous power centers next to each other, in and around Shanghai. With foreign wealth and cheap local labor, the village grew to one million by 1900. The city became very westernized as foreigners built buildings in their own styles. Chinese servants, child-slave labor, and prostitution became part of the imprint of westernization.

After World War II, the communists chose Shanghai to become the first Cultural Revolution "model city." Rehabilitation of opium addicts and the outlawing of child-slave labor credit their efforts.

Overcrowding and unemployment plague the streets. People coming from rural villages are returned because there just is not enough room for them to live and work.

- 1. Pray for the university students who seek meaning in life. They willingly listen to the gospel's proclamation and do not resist its truth when they understand it.
- 2. Prosperity and materialism have gripped the hearts of the people, with money becoming the most important factor in their lives. Pray against this spirit of mammon and greed.

City Significance/History:
Legend tells that the city started after five goats with rice stalks in their mouths descended from heaven. The gods gave the rice and goats as a symbol of freedom from famine, but famines have still come. Guangzhou is also known as Yangcheng, "goat city."

More than any other city in China, Guangzhou (Canton) has been the gateway for trade into China. As early as the second century, traders from the Roman Empire and India came to exchange goods. In the 16th century, Jesuit missionariaes established a work in the city. The next few centuries brought more traders and foreign powers to the area. Robert Morison, the first Protestant missionary, also entered China through Guangzhou in 1807. By the time Mao closed the door to missions, a total of one million Christians were in the

Opium became a necessary obsession for the wealthy Chinese. The British brought opium from India to meet the ever-growing demands of the Chinese addicts. The emperor of China finally ordered the city's regional head to get fid of the British. At the conclusion of the Opium War (1839-42), the Chinese surrounded the British, killing many and driving the remaining out of the area—thus ending another violent period.

- 1. Pray for the growth and outreach of the harassed house churches such as the well-known 33 Damazhan, and for the safety of their pastors.
- 2. Ask God to soften the hearts of the Religious Affairs Bureau officials who are antagonistic toward believers who remain outside the TSPM umbrella
- 3. Pray that the gospel can be ministered effectively in the midst of social change, economic prosperity, and new ideas and trends flooding in from the outside
- 4. Pray that students at the Theological Seminary affiliated with the TSPM Dong Shan Church would be called as pastors and evangelists to the growing church.
- 5. Children are used as tools for getting money. Pray for these children in bondage to begging. Pray also for the women caught in a life of prostitution.
